Lisa "SelahRae" DuBois is the founder of **The Synoptik Lenzs™ LLC** and **The Synoptik Lenzs™ Ministries**, a creative ministry dedicated to equipping, educating, and transforming lives through the power of words, creativity, and biblical truth. As an ordained minister, educator, author, and spoken-word artist, she combines theology, dramatic storytelling, and the creative arts to reach audiences both inside and outside traditional church settings. Her passion is to see the dramatic presentation of Scripture become a powerful voice in mainstream media — on stage and on screen.

L.S. DuBois is a minister, writer, author, playwright, poet, and creative entrepreneur, known under the moniker SelahRae, The Disruptive Ministering Poet. She stands at the intersection of faith, culture, and unapologetic expression. As the founder of **The Synoptik Lenzs™ LLC**, she has built a platform dedicated to elevating urban literary arts beyond stereotypes — challenging audiences to think deeper, feel harder, and confront truth without filters.

A native of Philadelphia and a product of the Philadelphia Public School System, DuBois was once labeled learning disabled. Only by the grace of God has she come full circle, now serving as a gifted and explosive teacher for youth and young adults. She is an advocate for education and a graduate of Philadelphia Biblical University and Missio Seminary, and is currently a student at United Theological Seminary pursuing a Ph.D. in Theology and the Arts.

DuBois is a certified Career & Technical Education (CTE) instructor in cosmetology and an academic English Language Arts educator. She brings both academic structure and real-world experience into her work, teaching writing, communication, financial literacy, and creative entrepreneurship to high school students and aspiring writers alike. Her approach blends discipline with divine calling — grounded in the belief that creativity is not just talent, but responsibility.

DuBois was licensed as a minister, receiving her training at Triumph Baptist Church in Philadelphia, PA. She was later ordained as an Elder at Kingdom Life Church Ministries. DuBois now serves at The Resurrection Center in Wilmington, Delaware as the drama ministry leader and with the Levitical order as a minister. Throughout her evangelical career, DuBois has served as an associate minister, Elder, youth worker, and Bible study and Sunday school teacher. She is a multi-creative servant of God.

As a poet, DuBois explores a wide range of themes: love, identity, faith, culture, power, and the psychological battles that shape human behavior. Her work is known for its raw honesty, spiritual undertones, respectfully sensual expression, and emotional intensity — often leaving audiences challenged, entertained, and ministered to. As a playwright, she develops stage productions that merge drama with spoken word, creating immersive experiences that push beyond entertainment into revelation. Her works include *House of Jubilee* and *Enterprise: When Power Becomes Pride*.

As an author, DuBois is committed to helping creatives turn their voice into viable income streams. Through her books and online teaching, Creative Conversations, she equips writers with the systems, strategies, mindset, and biblical understanding needed to build sustainable creative businesses that glorify God — without compromising ownership or authenticity.

She is a graduate of Philadelphia Biblical University with a Bachelor of Science in Biblical Studies, Missio Seminary with a Master's in Divinity, and is currently a student at United Theological Seminary pursuing a Ph.D. in Theology and Creative Arts.
